

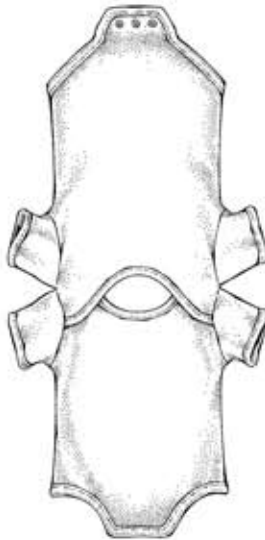
Folding Shirts

Our Folding Shirts are fun, quick, and easy to make! Just stamp, cut out, and fold for a shaped card or gift holder!

Folding Shirts can be used as greeting cards, invitations, or announcements. Or, fill the inside of shirts with gift cards, tea bags, candy, photographs, movie tickets, sticky note pads, mini photo albums, sewing kits, or other small treats and favors. They are also a great addition to a scrapbook page!

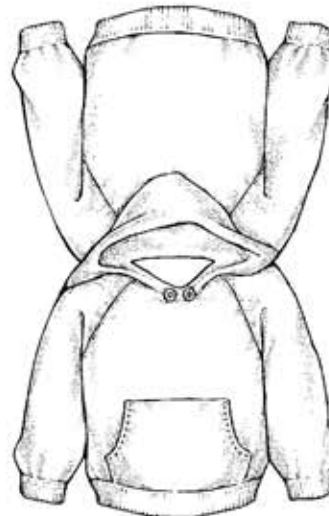


Insert our 3" separating zippers into the Zippered Jacket design to actually open and close the card! After stamping the Zippered Jacket, cut off the zipper that is drawn into the design. Then simply attach the real zipper with double-sided "red line" tape. (See our Folding Shirt demonstration in the Demo section of our website for detailed instructions.) Zippers and red line tape can be purchased in the "Folding Shirts" category of our online shopping section.



Our favorite way to make Folding Shirts is to stamp on patterned papers and scrapbooking papers with small prints. These types of papers give your shirts a realistic look. (They can also be stamped onto plain cardstock.) For more detail, glue on our tiny buttons and attach our 3" wire hangers to the inside of the shirts. Just attach these embellishments with a clear-drying glue.

Make your stamped Folding Shirts dimensional by stamping portions of the image twice. For example, stamp two hoods and pockets for the Hooded Sweatshirt, an extra collar for the Polo Shirt or Shirt and Tie, or extra sleeves for the Cardigan Sweater or Coat. Cut out the extra parts and use small pieces of foam tape to attach them to the appropriate places on the original shirts.



The T Shirt, Hooded Sweatshirt, and V Neck Shirt designs have open areas that can be embellished with stickers, sports team logos, and funny sayings.
