

Folios

Folios are made with two stamps and create pockets that can be filled with gifts and favors or be utilized as unique cards and invitations!

Here are lots of ideas for using Folios:

Create greeting cards for holidays, birthdays, graduations, weddings, and more. Write your message directly on the inside of the Folio or enclose your greeting on a 4" square card.

Use as invitations for weddings, showers, birthday parties, and dinner parties.

Fill with small gifts and party favors:

- gift cards
- packages of cookies
- candy
- tea bags
- hot chocolate mix
- jewelry
- seed packets
- stickers
- sewing kits

Make into small books by filing with:

- 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" sticky note pads
- journals (tie 4" squares of paper together with a fiber or ribbon and attach to the inside of a Folio)

- photo albums (fill wallet photo inserts with pictures and attach to the inside.)

Use as the focal point on a scrapbook page.

Attach a finished Folio to your page and open it to view a photo and journaling.



Folios are easy to make. Just stamp a Folio Bottom on a sheet of cardstock. (Place your cardstock horizontally on your work table and stamp the Bottom at a diagonal on your paper. Doing so will allow the entire stamped Folio design to easily fit on 8 1/2" x 11" paper.)

Next, stamp a coordinating Folio Side along each side of the Folio Bottom. (We mount the rubber die of the Folio Side right along the edge of the maple block for easy alignment. See our Folio demonstration in the Demo section of our website for more placement tips.) Color and cut out the Folio, then score the sides. Fold the sides in order and tuck the last one under the first, as if tucking in the top of a box.

When using a Folio as a card or invitation, it can be mailed to the recipient. Place a sticker or seal on the front to secure the folded flaps and address the open area on the back. (The Postal Service charges a small amount of extra postage when mailing this way, due to the Folio's square shape. To qualify for regular postage rates, the Folio can be mailed in a rectangular-shaped envelope.)

Get two distinctly different "looks" from your Folio! When the sides are folded in a clockwise direction, one image will appear. When folded counter-clockwise, you'll see a different image.
