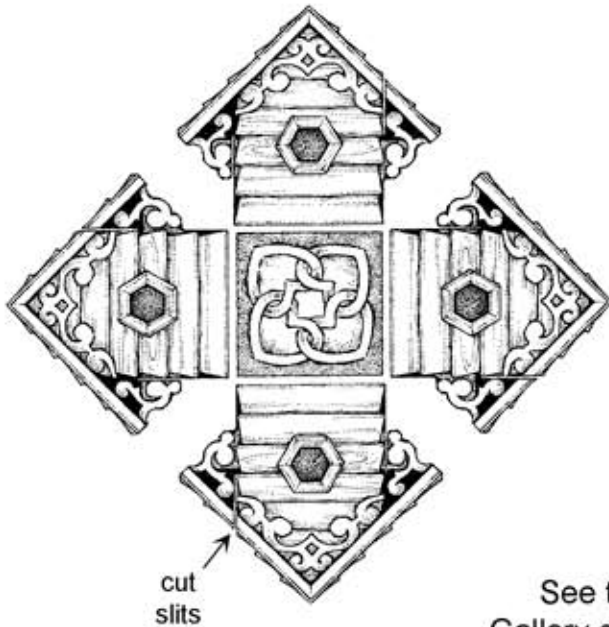


# Open Boxes

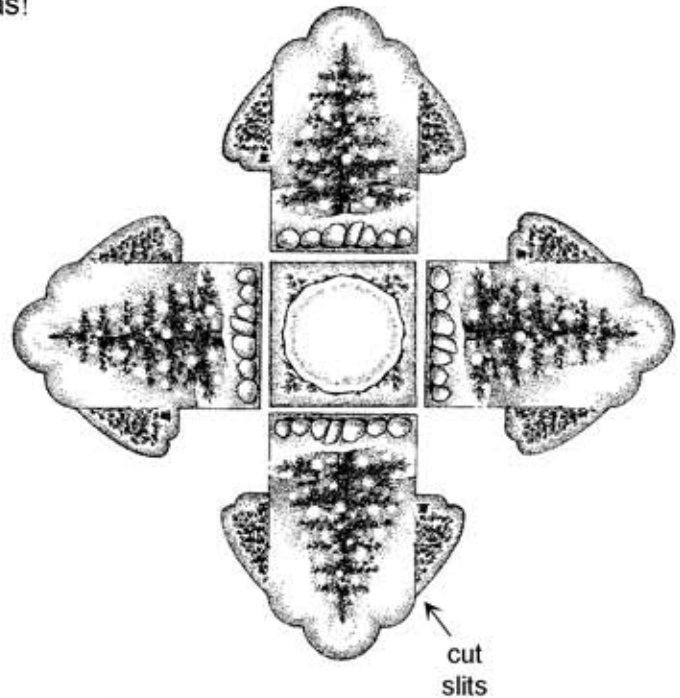
Open Boxes are fun little containers for party favors and small gifts! Line them with tissue paper, netting, or confetti shreds and fill with candy, tea bags, votive candle cups, and other tiny treasures. Create little baskets by embellishing finished Open Boxes with wire, ribbon, or raffia handles.

Toomuchfun offers many styles of Open Box designs for various holidays, seasons, and special occasions. Matching Folio designs are available for many of the Open Box styles.

Open Boxes are very easy to make! Stamp a Box Bottom in the center of a sheet of cardstock. (Position the Box Bottom diagonally on your cardstock to allow the entire stamped design to easily fit on 8 1/2" x 11" paper.) Next, stamp a coordinating Box Side along each edge of the stamped Box Bottom. (We mount the rubber die of the Box Side right along the edge of the maple block, which allows for easy alignment.) Color, then cut out the Open Box. Cut on the indicated slits, fold up the Box Sides, and interlock the slits.



Assemble Boxes by interlocking the sides at the indicated slits.
